TOWN OF WESTERLO TOWN BOARD BUDGET REVIEW WORKSHOP WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2014

The Town of Westerlo Town Board met on Wednesday, October 29, 2014 at 7:00 PM in the Town Hall to review the 2015 Tentative Budget as prepared and resubmitted by Pattison, Koskey, Howe, & Bucci on Oct. 29, 2014 to include the submission of the 2015 Westerlo Volunteer Fire Co. Budget figures.

The Town Board discussed and reviewed the budgets as submitted by Westerlo Vol. Fire Company, Westerlo Rescue Squad, & Westerlo Public Library.

- **FIRE** Company 2015 Budget- Supervisor Rapp reported: \$191,305 increased by \$3,500. Discussion followed Councilman Bichteman reported he would like to see more detailed information. Board agreed in favor with budget figure for now.
- **RESCUE** Squad 2015 Budget remains same as previous yr. \$100,000 Board agreed in favor of budget..
- LIBRARY 2015 Budget- Per letter from President, Board of Trustees Laura Tenney; \$73,474 an increase (3.19%) from previous yr. —Councilman Sherman asked questions regarding Library Budget and a discussion followed on budget figure totals, and Capital Reserve Fund a new line item to replenish fund. Board agreed in favor of budget.
- MUSEUM 2015 Budget-\$7,000. Supervisor Rapp reported he hadn't received a 2015 Museum Budget. Discussion followed on previous year's budget amount of \$11,000. Supervisor Rapp reported the elimination of a position the reason for cost savings. Board agreed in favor.

WATER FUND- Board agreed in favor. Councilman Bichteman discussed potentially changing the Water District quarterly payment schedule in the future. Currently the Westerlo Water District No. 1 quarterly payment schedule falls on the 15th of each of the following months; November, February, May, and August.

Highway Salaries-No increases

The Town Board agreed the following changes be made to the 2015 Tentative Budget(10/29/2014):

1410/Town Clerk- The Town Board discussed the Town Clerk's proposed budget request. Councilman Sherman had questions regarding figures provided by Pattison, Koskey, Howe & Bucci which lumped all salaries together under A-1410.1. After discussion and review the Town Board agreed in favor of the following changes:

A-1410.1 Town Clerk – from \$34,500 to \$40,700

A-1410.11 Deputy Town Clerk- proposed salary increase was denied. Addition of a 2nd Deputy Clerk budgeted at \$6,400-was agreed upon

A-1410.2 Clerk Capital Outlay- Unchanged

A-1410.4 Contractual changed from \$5,000 to \$5,500.

- 4540/Ambulance (Albany County EMS) Town Board to increase from \$84,500 to \$90,000.
- 8010/Zoning –Proposed budget figure of \$12,600. Town Board agreed to change amount in account code 8010.1 and correct from \$12,600 to \$13,875, & account code 8010.4 remain \$500.
- 8020/Planning: Code 8020.1 correct amount from \$11,100 to \$14,875 and 8020.4 amount to remain \$1,000.
- 7550/Celebrations: Change code 7550.4 from \$500 to \$1,000 and change code 7550.41
 WestCAC from \$500. to \$0.
